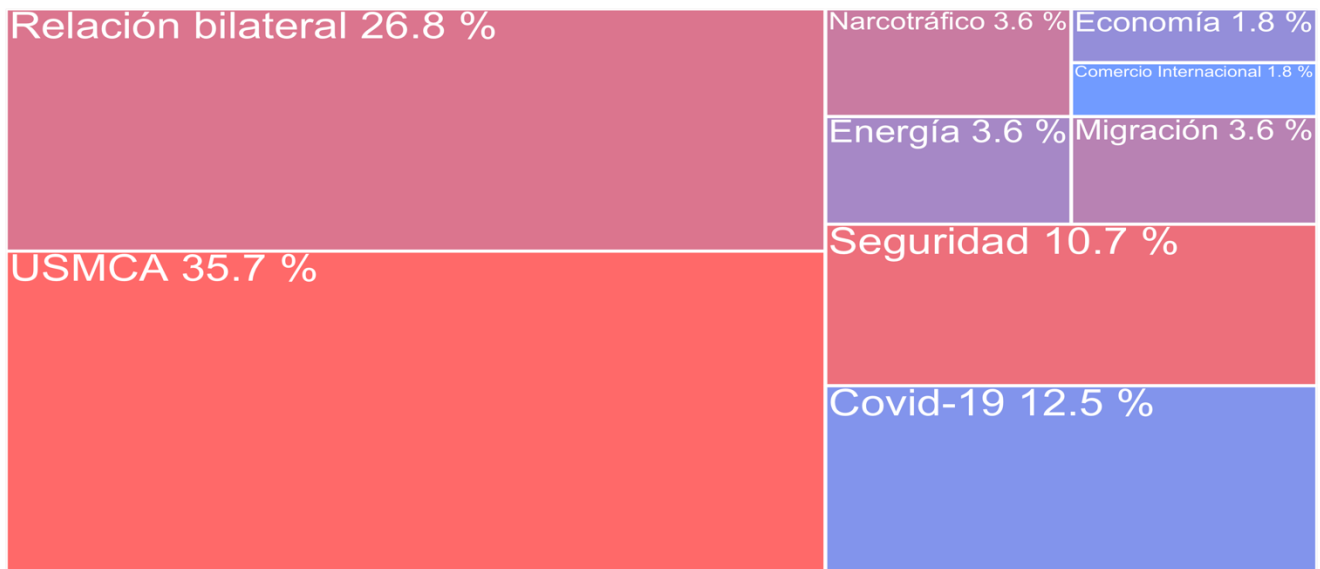
Julio 1 – Julio 28 de 2020

Durante el periodo se recopilaron 56 notas relacionadas con la relación bilateral entre México y Estados.

Ocho de las 37 notas fueron publicadas por centros en México, mientras que las 48 restantes fueron publicadas por seis centros en Estados Unidos. Mexico Institute fue el centro con más publicaciones relacionadas con el tema (18 notas).

Finalmente, 20 de las 56 notas mencionan algo relacionado con el tema “USMCA”, 15 de ellas mencionan el tema “Relación bilateral”, y las restantes se distribuyen entre 7 categorías relacionadas con Covid-19, Seguridad, Energía, Migración, Narcotráfico, entre otras.
